



GAMING ENTERTAINMENT PAVILION HIGHLIGHTS

FORTNITE GAMING TOURNAMENT:

- Will be hosting a Fortnite Gaming Tournament with over R100,000 prize pool and other prizes.
- There are 2 x tournaments – one final will be held per weekend.
- **How can I enter?**
 - Entry will be via an online registration system that goes live on 25 February. You can click on this link to register <http://randshow.co.za/gaming/> or you can take your chances and try and qualify at the Rand Show, dates indicated below. Entry at the Rand Show will be on a first-come-first-served basis on the day.
- **Is there an entry fee for the tournament?** Although entry to the online and onsite qualifiers are free, entry into the Rand show is R150 per person, but if you buy your tickets now there is an early bird special that includes entry into the Rand Show & Gaming Entertainment Pavilion where the tournament will be held at a cost of R100 per person. Tickets are on sale now at Computicket (<https://online.computicket.com/web/>). Early bird tickets are limited so book early to avoid disappointment.
- **What platform is the tournament being played on?** Online qualifiers are open to players on Xbox One and PS4 consoles, but venue qualifiers & final events will be played on PS4. This is to ensure an equal playing field.

- **Is there an age rating?** Due to the FPB age rating in South Africa for the Fortnite game being 16, participants must be 16 and over. The international age rating is 13 years, so exceptions will be made with parental guidance only. A parent must sign an indemnity form and must be present at all times should the player be younger than 16 years. No competitors younger than 13 will be allowed to participate.

COSPLAY TOURNAMENTS:

- Will be hosting an informal cosplay masquerade and a traditional cosplay tournament over both weekends.
- **Why host two different types of Cosplay competitions?** As the Rand Show endeavours to expand its content, we wanted to create a competition that will attract a wider participation and appeal to newcomers & experienced cosplayers.
- **What is a Cosplay Masquerade?** It is a more relaxed approach to cosplay that will encourage beginners to participate with prizes being awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places. Participants will be required to do a skit on stage. It will take place on Weekend 1 of the Rand Show
- **What is the traditional Cosplay tournament?** The Rand Show Cosplay Competition will be held on Weekend 2 and will be judged on three categories; Newcomers, Like a Boss and Beast Mode.
 - **Newcomer category** of the Rand Show and is open to newcomers, casual cosplayers and kids/teens (ages 6-12 and 13-15). Past competition cosplays are welcome. First, second and third place will be awarded to the various age groups.
 - **Like a Boss category** is an intermediate competition. It is open to all, except experienced cosplayers. Beginners are welcome to enter as well. Pre-Judging and skit judging will take place. Past competition cosplays are welcome. First, second and third place will be awarded.
 - **Beast Mode category** is an experienced competition and is only open to experienced cosplayers. Pre-Judging and skit judging will take place. Past competition cosplays are welcome.
 - Group entries will need to be done by one member, all members names and details will be required, see link below for more information
- **How can I enter?**
 - Entry will be via an online registration system that goes live on 25 February 2019. You can click on this link to register www.randshow.co.za/cosplay/
- **Is there an entry fee for the tournament?** Although entry to the cosplay tournament is free, entry into the Rand show is R150 per person, but if you buy your tickets now there is an early bird special that includes entry into the Rand Show & Gaming Entertainment Pavilion where the tournament will be held at a cost of R100 per person. Tickets are on sale now at Computicket (<https://online.computicket.com/web/>). Early bird tickets are limited so book early to avoid disappointment.
- **Is there an age limit?** This is no age limit for the Cosplay Masquerade however for the traditional Cosplay Tournament – Beast Mode category, entrants must be 16 and older.
- **Are there age categories for the Cosplay Masquerade?** Yes, categories have been split into Children 6-12 years, Teens 13-15 years, adult 16 and upwards.
- All costumes must be from the world of comics/anime/manga/gaming/movies & TV

DANCE TOURNAMENT:

- A Fortnite inspired dance off competition will be held at the Rand Show in the Gaming Entertainment Pavilion (Hall 9) during operating times
- There will be various daily prizes up for grabs every day.
- Entries from 25 February – 31 March 2019 will be considered.
- **How do I enter?** You will need to upload a 15 second video clip of yourself performing your favourite Fortnite inspired dance moves to the Rand Show Facebook or Instagram pages. Make sure you tag us using the handle #RSDanceOff, #randshow2019 and make sure you like our page. Any videos that don't include the hashtag will be disqualified.

- **What happens next?** Should your dance video be selected, you will be notified via direct message on the various social media platforms. We will then require an email address or phone number to communicate further information at a later stage. Our events team will advise you of the date and time you will be competing. If you are unable to come to the show on that day, an alternative date will be provided.
- **Is there a criteria that dances will be judged on?** No, there is no specific criteria, we are just looking to reward good talent – get creative.
- **Is there an age limit?** No – all ages are welcome

GAMING ENTERTAINMENT PAVILION

- **Where is the Rand Show?** At the Johannesburg Expo Centre, Nasrec
- **Where is the Gaming Entertainment Pavilion?** Hall 9





- **What does it cost?** Access to the Gaming Entertainment Pavilion is R20 per person per time slot. You will need to buy a ticket to the Rand Show which costs R150 per person for the day. If you buy your tickets now there is an early bird special that includes entry into the Rand Show & Gaming Entertainment Pavilion at a cost of R100 per person. Tickets are on sale now at Computicket (<https://online.computicket.com/web/>). Early bird tickets are limited so book early to avoid disappointment.
- **What does the R20 per time slot get me?** You will have access to the Gaming Entertainment Pavilion for 2 hours, you will get a wristband which will indicate which time slot you have purchased. Once your 2 hours are over, you will be escorted from the Hall and the next group will be allowed in. Wristbands will be handed out at the Gaming Entertainment Pavilion entrance.
- **Can I buy a ticket at the Gaming Entertainment Pavilion?** Yes you can, ticket stations will be situated by Hall 9, cash and credit cards will be accepted.
- **Can I buy multiple time slots for the Gaming Entertainment Pavilion?** Yes you can, tickets per time slot are limited to ensure all visitors have a good experience, you can purchase these at Rand Show Computicket box office outside Hall 9
- **Will there be other games to see and play besides Fortnite?** Yes there will be, keep an eye on our social media pages to see what will be featured.
- **What can I expect to see in the Gaming Entertainment Pavilion?** Fornite Gaming Tournament, Dance Off competition, Cosplay tournaments, VR Experience, NAG Nerf Arena, Gaming vendors with other gaming content to experience and enjoy, retailers selling gaming related products and software, Tutorials & workshops on how to improve your gaming skills, Celebrity Fortnite match off and much much more.
